


From the CEO

Quadruple Accreditation

Orontide operates under a structured and accredited Integrated Management System for occupational health, safety, quality and environmental management. This system was first established and accredited in Henderson in July 1994, and has a strong focus on hazard identification and risk control, effective tools and processes, education and training, open and consultative communication on safety matters, and continual improvement. Continuous HSEQ accreditation for a period of 20 years is an outstanding achievement that the Orontide team are extremely proud of.



In January 2013, Orontide Group Limited chose to further enhance its accreditation by consolidating all of its operational sites around Australia into a single suite of certificates, and adding an additional international safety certification. The company achieved quadruple HSEQ systems accreditation after a rigorous audit and compliance review process conducted by Bureau Veritas. Under this accreditation, Orontide's systems comply with the following standards:

- International standard for quality management systems (ISO9001);
- Australian standard for safety management systems (AS4801)
- International standard for occupational health and safety systems (ISO18001); and
- International standard for environmental management systems (ISO14001).

In the News

Orontide's work has been featured in various publications throughout 2013. Our most recent coverage was the inclusion of our work on a series of 11 pipeline buckle initiators for the Gorgon Project in the October issue of Oil and Gas Australia.



Orontide was one of only a few WA companies to work on the project, in this instance providing material processing, fabrication, machining, surface treatment and assembly services and factory acceptance testing for the skids.

South West News

New Acquisitions for Bunbury

Orontide's commitment to investing in equipment, technology and safety has continued as our South West site took possession of two new CNC machines last year. The machines were supplied by Mazak, one of the world's leading CNC machine manufacturers and upgrade existing machines with the latest technology.



The first of these machines is an Integrex I-300, a multi-tasking CNC capable of doing both turning and milling in the one machine. The second machine is a Vertical Machine Centre VCN 700D-11.

These latest machines will increase efficiencies in our current work load and the I-300 will increase our capabilities to conduct 5 axis simultaneous machining where movement in different directions at the same time is required, for example the machining of propellers.

Since installation of the new machines, they have been used extensively to deliver high end machining components for a number of clients, including GE.

Recent Projects

Pipe Spool Work— Woodside

In November, Orontide was awarded work for Woodside's offshore assets. The work involved fabrication of CuNi (Copper-Nickel) spools. Work has been carried out in our purpose-built exotics bay at Orontide where all specialised work of this nature is carried out. Fabrication was carried out in accordance with ASME IX, welds radiographically tested and all spools pressure tested to 3000 KPa.



Specialised Coatings— NEMO Kongsberg/ Apache

A recently completed project has seen Orontide deliver an Australian first in specialised coatings. When Orontide were awarded a contract by NEMO Kongsberg to paint the cooling pipes on the Apache Cooling Skid, a set of unique challenges saw the need for an innovative solution.



Changing temperatures during operation of the Cooling Skid meant that the thermal efficiency of the paint controlled by the limited thickness and anti-fouling properties became key drivers to the success of this work.

A specialised coating with superior anti-fouling and thermal efficiency properties had to be sourced from overseas to address these issues effectively. With no previous use of this product in Australia, a specialist was flown in from the UK to assist with the pre-qualification process.

The pre-qualification and testing phase was a success with Orontide meeting the tight timeframe ensuring production commenced without delay.



Preservation and Maintenance—Vermilion Oil and Gas

Orontide's contract providing a range of site based services on both Wandoo A and B has recently been extended for another 12 months. The scope of work includes preservation and maintenance of the helideck, main walkways and various hot spot areas using a range of different preparation methods from mechanical to Ultra High Pressure (UHP) water jetting.
