

## Fabric Maintenance Contract Awarded

Orontide Industrial Services are pleased to announce the successful award of the Fabric Maintenance Service contract for PTTEP AA's Montara Venture FPSO.

Orontide will be completing numerous scopes of work during the three year campaign including blasting and coating of structural elements, vessels, piping, equipment, valves and other items as required. Additional works to mitigate external corrosion on mechanical joints by wrapping them to prevent moisture ingress using PTTEP AA's approved procedure will also be included in the campaign.

## Protection of Spares for Asset Life Extension

A recent request to supply spare parts to a large mining client gave our Bunbury team the opportunity to assess their long term storage practices.

On inspection of conveyor gears, shafts and other rotating equipment that had been in storage for many years without adequate protection, significant dust build-up and corrosion had occurred—despite being stored inside.

Orontide's Industrial and Engineering Services teams were engaged to rectify the long term storage issues and increase the life of these assets to ensure they were "fit for purpose" when required in the Plant.

The process to restore the condition of the deteriorated equipment involved initial cleaning using high pressure water blasting before the spares were inspected for integrity and damage. A thermoplastic coating was applied to critical diameters to protect against corrosion before all components were packed into custom built crates ready for a possible 25 years of storage.



## Demand for Specialised Site Services Continues

Orontide Port Hedland has recently been awarded a new Goods and Services Contract for a major iron ore company for the "Supply of Mechanical Maintenance Services" on behalf of Orontide Group.

Orontide were the only local Port Hedland based Company to succeed on this tender beating strong competition in a very thorough tender process to win the five year Contract. Awarded at a time when market conditions are extremely tight and competitive, this is a significant milestone for Orontide providing the foundation for significant growth of our Site Services Division in the Resources sector.

This Contract will provide site work opportunities for all Orontide Business units with the option to extend the term by an additional five years upon completion.
